
#### Step 1:

- Select the Vegas preset

How to select a preset is described in the main manual.


## Step 2:

- Open Vegas
- Click on Options->Preferences...




## Step 3:

- Go to MIDI
- Check all devices containing D400




#### Step 4:

- Go to External Control & Automation
- Press Add




# Step 5:

- Click Add Emulated Mackie Control Device in the list
- Select Emulated Mackie Control Device
- Select **D400** as input and output



## Step 6:


Check External Control as shown below



# Step 7: (optional)


If you want to connect more than one extension, you should redo step 3 and
 5 but select D400 (2) and Emulated Mackie Extender

If there is only one D400 showing up, you need to enable the extensions first. How you can do that is described in the main manual.



# Step 8: (optional)

- If you want to use all keys, you also need to add a Generic Control
- Click on an action you want to assign, press Edit..., check Learn, press a button
