This guide shows you how to set up the D700 in all DAW programs that are not explicitly mentioned in a separate guide and support the well-known HUI protocol. With this preset the D700 works as a HUI device.

All files mentioned in this guide can be found on the USB drive, in the Asparion Configurator installation folder or on our website.

If you are having trouble finding the mentioned windows and options, you should have a look at the manual of your DAW.

Step 1:

- Check if your software supports **HUI**
- Select the **HUI** preset

How to select a preset is described in the main manual.

Step 2:

- Open your DAW program
- Find the **Options** or **Preferences** window
- Go to **Control Surfaces**, **Midi Controllers** or **Midi** and enable **HUI** while selecting **D700** as input and output

Step 3: (optional)

- If you want to connect more than one extension, you should redo step 2 but select **D700 (2)**

If there is only one D700 showing up, you need to enable the extensions first. How you can do that is described in the main manual.

Hints:

- In the HUI preset these are the corresponding keys. Generally, you can assign a function to those keys in the settings of your DAW

D700	HUI
Magic *	F1
Volume Click	F2

Attention! Given that the resolution of a LED ring in the HUI protocol is only 11 it might seem like the LED ring jumps.

Attention! Given that the HUI protocol has no dedicated master volume control the encoder might not have the desired function. You can use it as a jog wheel surrogate to scroll or zoom.
