Waveform

This guide shows you how to set up the D700 in Waveform. All pictures provided were taken with Waveform 12 but it is also applicable to most other Waveform versions.

All files mentioned in this guide can be found on the USB drive, in the Asparion Configurator installation folder or on our website.

Step 1:

- Select the Waveform preset

How to select a preset is described in the main manual.

Step 2:

- Copy the file "Asparion D700.js" to Waveform

Windows:




Step 3:

- Open Waveform
- Click on **Settings** and select **MIDI Devices**
- Enable all devices containing **D700**




Step 4:

- Go to **Control Surfaces**
- Select **Asparion D700** and set **D700** as **Input** and **Output**




Step 5: (optional)

- If you want to connect more than one extension, you should also set **Extenders** to **1** and select **D700 (2)** as **Input** and **Output**
If there is only one D700 showing up, you need to enable the extensions first. How you can do that is described in the main manual.



Step 6: (optional)

- Click **MIDI Learn**
- Here you can assign functions to every button as you desire



Hints:

- With the knob **EQ**, you can assign the **Marker Mode** to the encoders. By clicking the specific encoder Waveform will jump to that marker
- With the knob **FX**, you can assign the currently selected plugin to the encoders
- With the knob **Send**, you can assign the Aux Sends to the encoders. Make sure your track actually has an Aux Send effect
- To reset a parameter, click the encoder
- To switch trough banks for **EQ**, **FX** and **Send** double click the bank switch buttons
